On 13th August 2008 the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above order (with modifications).

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from GR ST69270560 (Point A) running north west for 199 metres to GR ST69110571 (Point C) and create an alternative footpath instead on a line running from GR ST69270559 (Point H) running west for 20 metres to GR ST69250560 (Point G), then north north west for 13 metres to GR ST69240560 (Point F), then west for 36 metres to GR ST69200561 (Point E), then north for 30 metres to GR ST69200564 (Point D) (2 metres width between points H, G, F, E and D), then north west for 122 metres to GR ST69110571 (point C) (1.5 metres width between Points D and C) as shown on the Order Map.

A copy of the confirmed Order and the Order may be seen free of charge at The Council Offices, Stratton House, Dorchester/The Manor house, Newland, Sherborne from 9.00am to 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there at the price of £1.

This Order comes into force on the date on which West Dorset District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or that or any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of schedule 14 to the Act.
